

Help Your Teen Be a Safe, Responsible Driver

As a parent you can:



- ✓ Set the rules of the road
- ✓ Drive safely and obey all traffic laws
- ✓ Log your teen driver's behind-the-wheel practice
- ✓ Supervise required 50 hours of practice driving
- ✓ Attend parent night at your teen's driving school
- ✓ Enforce intermediate license restrictions
- ✓ Coach good driving skills



Enforce Intermediate License Restrictions

From Issue Date To Age 18



No driving between 1 a.m. and 5 a.m.*



No passengers first 6 months | Up to 3 passengers <20 years old after 6 months**



No cell phones

* Unless accompanied by parent, guardian or licensed driver 25 years old or older
**Except immediate family members
